

## **DIRECT APPLIED STUCCO TO AUSSIE SHIELD™ 300-PLM**

The following AVM Industries Technical Bulletin is to address direct application of stucco to Aussie Shield™ 300-PLM STPE based Air Barrier.

## This procedure has been in practice with STPE based Air Barrier products for many years with good results.

- 1) Prepare substrates per instructions and apply a minimum of 20 mils of 300-PLM.
- 2) Cast clean, dry sand (see note below\*) into the 300-PLM as soon as possible. If the 300-PLM has started to skin-over, then you will need to apply another coat and begin again. Note that skin-over time will vary significantly depending on temperature and humidity.
- 3) After the 300-PLM is completely cured out, apply the first lift of stucco a hawk and trowel application technique tends to work the best.
- 4) Working in the shade provides the best results due to the slowing of the evaporation of water.
- 5) Keep the new stucco hydrated, especially in hot, dry conditions. This may be the single most crucial step to a successful project.
- 6) The bonding between the lifts is generally the issue, not the adhesion of the sand to the 300-PLM or the adhesion of the scratch coat to the sand
  - \* AVM recommends Round Sand in the 20 to 40 mesh range. These types of sand are readily available at Distributors of Deck Coatings and other materials.
